NEW BUSINESS: Michelle Iwaniw and Ryan Dudley discussed the H-NNCSB's desire to add four new sites to its existing Therapeutic Day Treatment Program. Currently, the program operates at Bridgeport Academy. The H-NNCSB seeks to add such a program to the South Morrison, Carver, Riverside and Marshall Elementary Schools in Newport News. Each school would have one classroom for the program with a full time counselor and up to twelve students. The Therapeutic Day Treatment Program has already been approved by the LHRC and is subject to H-NNCSB's standing Human Rights policies.

ACTION: A motion was made as follows: "Motion to approve the H-NNCSB's expansion of its Therapeutic Day Treatment Program to the South Morrison, Carver, Riverside and Marshall Elementary Schools in Newport News." The motion was seconded and unanimously approved without further discussion.

ADVOCATE REPORT: Willie Barnes announced that training that will be provided to LHRC members at the Southeast Virginia Training Center in Chesapeake. The training will be from 9:00 a.m. to noon on September 17, 2008. More information and invitations to follow.
